Who is Jesus? - Scriptural References

- 1Ti 2:5 For *there is* one God, and <u>one mediator</u> between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;
- Joh 14:6 Jesus saith unto him, I am the <u>way</u>, <u>the truth</u>, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me.
- Ac 2:36 Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ.
- Ac 4:27 For of a truth against thy holy child Jesus, whom thou hast <u>anointed</u>, both Herod, and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles, and the people of Israel, were gathered together,
- Ac 10:38 How God <u>anointed</u> Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.
- Mt 16:16 And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God.
- Mt 16:20 Then charged he his disciples that they should tell no man that he was Jesus the Christ.
- Mt 26:63 But Jesus held his peace. And the high priest answered and said unto him, I adjure thee by the living God, that thou tell us whether thou be the Christ, the Son of God.
- Mr 8:29 And he saith unto them, But whom say ye that I am? And Peter answereth and saith unto him, Thou art the Christ.
- Mr 14:61 But he held his peace, and answered nothing. Again the high priest asked him, and said unto him, Art thou the Christ, the Son of the Blessed?
- Lu 3:15 And as the people were in expectation, and all men mused in their hearts of John, whether he were the Christ, or not;
- Lu 9:20 He said unto them, But whom say ye that I am? Peter answering said, <u>The</u> Christ of God.
- Lu 22:67 Art thou the Christ? tell us. And he said unto them, If I tell you, ye will not believe:

- Joh 1:20 And he confessed, and denied not; but confessed, I am not the Christ.
- Joh 1:41 He first findeth his own brother Simon, and saith unto him, We have found the Messias, which is, being interpreted, the Christ.
- Joh 3:28 Ye yourselves bear me witness, that I said, I am not the Christ, but that I am sent before him.
- Joh 4:29 Come, see a man, which told me all things that ever I did: is not this the Christ?
- Joh 4:42 And said unto the woman, Now we believe, not because of thy saying: for we have heard *him* ourselves, and know that this is indeed the Christ, the Saviour of the world.
- Joh 7:41 Others said, This is the Christ. But some said, Shall Christ come out of Galilee?
- Joh 10:24 Then came the Jews round about him, and said unto him, How long dost thou make us to doubt? If thou be the Christ, tell us plainly.
- Joh 11:27 She saith unto him, Yea, Lord: I believe that thou art the Christ, the Son of God, which should come into the world.
- Joh 20:31 But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name.
- 1Jo 2:22 Who is a liar but he that denieth that Jesus is the <u>Christ</u>? He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son.
- 1Jo 5:1 Whosoever believeth that Jesus is the Christ is born of God: and every one that loveth him that begat loveth him also that is begotten of him.
- Mt 16:16 And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the <u>Son of the living God</u>.
- Joh 6:69 And we believe and are sure that thou art that Christ, the <u>Son</u> of the <u>living</u> God.
- Mt 8:29 And, behold, they cried out, saying, What have we to do with thee, Jesus, thou Son of God? art thou come hither to torment us before the time?
- Mt 14:33 Then they that were in the ship came and worshipped him, saying, Of a truth thou art the <u>Son of God</u>.
- Mt 26:63 But Jesus held his peace. And the high priest answered and said unto him, I adjure thee by the living God, that thou tell us whether thou be the Christ, the Son of God.

- Mt 27:40 And saying, Thou that destroyest the temple, and buildest *it* in three days, save thyself. If thou be the <u>Son of God</u>, come down from the cross.
- Mt 27:43 He trusted in God; let him deliver him now, if he will have him: for he said, I am the <u>Son of God</u>.
- Mt 27:54 Now when the centurion, and they that were with him, watching Jesus, saw the earthquake, and those things that were done, they feared greatly, saying, Truly this was the <u>Son of God</u>.
- Mr 1:1 The beginning of the gospel of Jesus Christ, the Son of God;
- Mr 3:11 And unclean spirits, when they saw him, fell down before him, and cried, saying, Thou art the <u>Son of God</u>.
- Mr 15:39 And when the centurion, which stood over against him, saw that he so cried out, and gave up the ghost, he said, Truly this man was the <u>Son of God</u>.
- Lu 1:35 And the angel answered and said unto her, The Holy Ghost shall come upon thee, and the power of the Highest shall overshadow thee: therefore also that holy thing which shall be born of thee shall be called the <u>Son of God</u>.
- Lu 3:38 Which was the son of Enos, which was the son of Seth, which was the son of Adam, which was the son of God.
- Lu 4:3 And the devil said unto him, If thou be the <u>Son of God</u>, command this stone that it be made bread.
- Lu 4:9 And he brought him to Jerusalem, and set him on a pinnacle of the temple, and said unto him, If thou be the <u>Son of God</u>, cast thyself down from hence:
- Lu 4:41 And devils also came out of many, crying out, and saying, Thou art Christ the Son of God. And he rebuking *them* suffered them not to speak: for they knew that he was Christ.
- Lu 8:28 When he saw Jesus, he cried out, and fell down before him, and with a loud voice said, What have I to do with thee, Jesus, *thou* Son of God most high? I beseech thee, torment me not.
- Lu 22:70 Then said they all, Art thou then the <u>Son of God</u>? And he said unto them, Ye say that I am.
- Joh 1:34 And I saw, and bare record that this is the **Son of God**.
- Joh 1:49 Nathanael answered and saith unto him, Rabbi, thou art the <u>Son of God</u>; thou art the King of Israel.

- Joh 3:18 He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten <u>Son of God</u>.
- Joh 5:25 Verily, verily, I say unto you, The hour is coming, and now is, when the dead shall hear the voice of the <u>Son of God</u>: and they that hear shall live.
- Joh 9:35 Jesus heard that they had cast him out; and when he had found him, he said unto him, Dost thou believe on the <u>Son of God</u>?
- Joh 10:36 Say ye of him, whom the Father hath sanctified, and sent into the world, Thou blasphemest; because I said, I am the <u>Son of God</u>?
- Joh 11:4 When Jesus heard *that*, he said, This sickness is not unto death, but for the glory of God, that the <u>Son of God</u> might be glorified thereby.
- Joh 11:27 She saith unto him, Yea, Lord: I believe that thou art the Christ, the Son of God, which should come into the world.
- Joh 19:7 The Jews answered him, We have a law, and by our law he ought to die, because he made himself the <u>Son of God</u>.
- Joh 20:31 But these are written, that ye might believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing ye might have life through his name.
- Ac 8:37 And Philip said, If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest. And he answered and said, I believe that Jesus Christ is the <u>Son of God</u>.
- Ac 9:20 And straightway he preached Christ in the synagogues, that he is the Son of God.
- Ro 1:4 And declared *to be* the <u>Son of God</u> with power, according to the spirit of holiness, by the resurrection from the dead:
- 2Co 1:19 For the Son of God, Jesus Christ, who was preached among you by us, *even* by me and Silvanus and Timotheus, was not yea and nay, but in him was yea.
- Ga 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the <u>Son of God</u>, who loved me, and gave himself for me.
- Eph 4:13 Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ:

- Heb 4:14 Seeing then that we have a great high priest, that is passed into the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast *our* profession.
- Heb 6:6 If they shall fall away, to renew them again unto repentance; seeing they crucify to themselves the <u>Son of God</u> afresh, and put *him* to an open shame.
- Heb 7:3 Without father, without mother, without descent, having neither beginning of days, nor end of life; but made like unto the <u>Son of God</u>; abideth a priest continually.
- Heb 10:29 Of how much sorer punishment, suppose ye, shall he be thought worthy, who hath trodden under foot the <u>Son of God</u>, and hath counted the blood of the covenant, wherewith he was sanctified, an unholy thing, and hath done despite unto the Spirit of grace?
- 1Jo 3:8 He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose the <u>Son of God</u> was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil.
- 1Jo 4:15 Whosoever shall confess that Jesus is the <u>Son</u> of <u>God</u>, God dwelleth in him, and he in God.
- 1Jo 5:5 Who is he that overcometh the world, but he that believeth that Jesus is the Son of God?
- 1Jo 5:10 He that believeth on the <u>Son of God</u> hath the witness in himself: he that believeth not God hath made him a liar; because he believeth not the record that God gave of his Son.
- 1Jo 5:12 He that hath the Son hath life; *and* he that hath not the <u>Son</u> <u>of God</u> hath not life.
- of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God.
- 1Jo 5:20 And we know that the <u>Son of God</u> is come, and hath given us an understanding, that we may know him that is true, and we are in him that is true, *even* in his Son Jesus Christ. This is the true God, and eternal life.
- Re 2:18 And unto the angel of the church in Thyatira write; These things saith the Son of God, who hath his eyes like unto a flame of fire, and his feet *are* like fine brass;

Where is Jesus?

- Mr 16:19 So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the <u>right hand of God</u>.
- Ac 2:33 Therefore being by the <u>right hand of God</u> exalted, and having received of the Father the promise of the Holy Ghost, he hath shed forth this, which ye now see and hear.
- Ac 7:55 But he, being full of the Holy Ghost, looked up stedfastly into heaven, and saw the glory of God, and Jesus standing on the <u>right hand of God</u>,
- Ac 7:56 And said, Behold, I see the heavens opened, and the Son of man standing on the right hand of God.
- Ro 8:34 Who *is* he that condemneth? *It is* Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the <u>right hand of God</u>, who also maketh intercession for us.
- Col 3:1 If ye then be risen with Christ, seek those things which are above, where Christ sitteth on the <u>right hand of God</u>.
- Heb 10:12 But this man, after he had offered one sacrifice for sins for ever, sat down on the right hand of God;
- 1Pe 3:22 Who is gone into heaven, and is on the <u>right hand of God</u>; angels and authorities and powers being made subject unto him.

Who is the Father?

- Joh 17:3 And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the <u>only true God</u>, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent.
- 2 Ch 15:3 Now for a long season Israel *hath been* without the <u>true</u> <u>God</u>, and without a teaching priest, and without law.
- Jer 10:10 But the LORD (Jahweh) *is* the <u>true</u> <u>God</u>, he *is* the living God, and an everlasting king: at his wrath the earth shall tremble, and the nations shall not be able to abide his indignation.
- Joh 17:3 And this is life eternal, that they might know thee the only <u>true God</u>, and Jesus Christ, whom thou hast sent.
- 1Th 1:9 For they themselves shew of us what manner of entering in we had unto you, and how ye turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God;

- 2Co 11:31 The God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which is blessed for evermore, knoweth that I lie not.
- Eph 1:3 Blessed *be* the <u>God and Father</u> of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly *places* in Christ:
- Eph 4:6 One God and Father of all, who *is* above all, and through all, and in you all.
- 1Pe 1:3 Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

Father and Son

- 1 Cor. 15:22 For as in Adam all die, so also in Christ shall all be made alive.
 - 23 But each in his own order: Christ the first fruits, then at his coming those who belong to Christ.
 - 24 Then comes the end, when he delivers the kingdom to God the Father after destroying every rule and every authority and power.
 - 25 For he must reign until he has put all his enemies under his feet.
 - 26 The last enemy to be destroyed is death.
 - 27 "For God has put all things in subjection under his feet." But when it says, "All things are put in subjection under him," it is plain that he is excepted who put all things under him.
 - When all things are subjected to him, then the Son himself will also be subjected to him who put all things under him, that God may be everything to everyone.
- Joh 14:28 Ye have heard how I said unto you, I go away, and come *again* unto you. If ye loved me, ye would rejoice, because I said, I go unto the Father: for my Father is greater than I.
